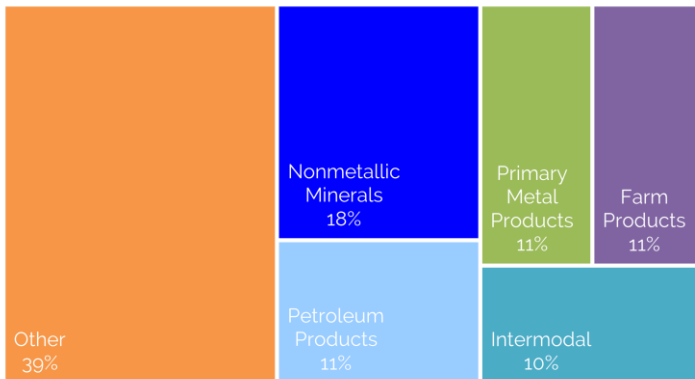


Sustainability:

Rail Traffic Originated in 2019 Total Tons: 54.6 million Total Carloads: 986,900

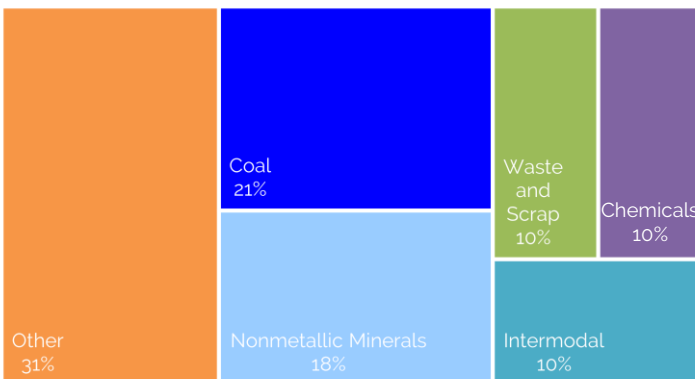
